Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

The weather was perfect and the setting ideal - with various teapots and cups & saucers collected by Jenny over the years. There was no special occasion, just a bucket list event shared with special women of the Knolls.



Preheat oven to 350 degrees

1/2 lb thinly sliced prosciutto

1 package Stonefire Flatbread

Ingredients:

1 jar Fig Jam

Prebake flatbreads on cookie sheet for 10 minutes.

Kelley Orsini's Prosciutto & Fig Flatbread Prepared by Karly Becker for a Tea Party

2/3 cup caramelized onions (at room temperature)

1 large and 1 small tube of goat cheese (at room temperature)

Remove from oven and thinly spread 3 heaping TBS of fig jam on each flatbread

Spread 1/3 cup of caramelized onions on each flatbread

Drop about 1 teasp of goat cheese every 2 inches or so ... I do 7 -8 dots the long ways and 3 dots

Distribute 1/4 lb of prosciutto on each flatbread ... I tear it into pieces and scatter it around, so every bite has prosciutto

Bake in 350-degree oven for 25 - 30 minutes. Watch it carefully so it doesn't burn Remove flatbreads from cookie sheet onto a cutting board to cool slightly. Cut into 2" squares.

THE SCZEPANSKI/HANNAN FAMILIES

The Sczepanski Family has enjoyed the beauty of the Knolls for well over 65 years. Ed Sczepanski (1924 - 2015) was born and raised in Ozone Park, NY and was a WWII Army Veteran. He became acquainted with the Knolls when he and a group of friends travelled up to Squantz Pond. Later the group included couples, and he and his wife, Helen, whom he married in 1952, became fond of the area and eventually they purchased a summer cottage on 17 North Beach Drive in August 1959.

Helen & Ed spent summers in the Knolls with their four children, Pat, Dan, Nancy, and Barbara. In 1967 a job change to the CT area had them looking for homes in Stamford and instead the family purchased a home on 12 Lake Shore South where they became all year-round residents of the Knolls. Back then there were under five families living year-round and a few more on weekends only. Ed worked for Consolidated Diesel Corporation in Old Greenwich as a Government Contracts Manager. Prior to his retirement, he worked for Duracell. In 1980, Helen & Ed

downsized to the house on 2 Claredal Avenue where Helen still resides.

Ed was awarded the Candlewood Knolls Lifetime Achievement Award in September 2009 for recognition and honor of his 30+ years of service to our community. He was a Board Member from 1968 – 1999 and President in 1985 &1986. While he was Vice President, he served as Chairman of the Tax District Committee, spearheaded its formation, and wrote the original by-laws of the Tax District.

The Sczepanski children have many fond memories of growing up in the Knolls, including the Farmhouse, Rock Lodge, and Teen Dances with the Isle. Their son Dan lives with his wife Jill in

Massachussets and has two married daughters who are both expecting their first child this year. Nancy (Hamilton) lives with her husband in Burlington, CT and Barbara lives in Knollcrest. Pat (Hannan) has been a Knolls neighbor almost her whole life. She taught elementary school for 42 years before retiring in 2019. She raised her children in the house on 8 Candlewood Knolls Road, then moved in 2006 to 18 North Beach Drive where she currently resides. Her son, Sean, started working in the Knolls cleaning the beaches in 1994 and has been working with the maintenance crew ever since. He is a jack of all trades and loves the outdoors. Daughter Katie, also a teacher, married Dennis Tibbits in 2014 and lives in New Fairfield with their two children, Sophie, 9, and Eddie, 6, who are 3rd generation campers!




