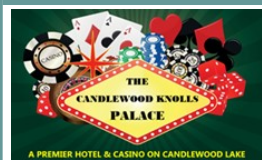
What an amazing night!! Thank you all for coming together to enjoy the Progressive Dinner on

Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
 - Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
 - Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
 - Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

The children in the Knolls have many opportunities to make friends through camp and beach play. Adults meet their neighbors while strolling through the Knolls on their daily walks, or sitting at the beaches, or mingling at the wide array of entertainment events held throughout the year (cocktail parties, theme parties, bocce nights, picnics, etc.) In the 80's and 90's there were several fashion shows held at the clubhouse that featured our own ladies as models. Some women played bridge and today they can take up yoga or play Mahjong on Monday evenings.

In the mid 90's Maria Stonecipher, along with her sisters Theresa Wohr and Gloria Craven, organized a new venue for the women to gather known as the "Progressive Dinner". The idea being that each year 3 women would volunteer to open their homes and host either appetizers, dinner, or dessert. Each host would be assigned a group of attendees to take care of all the food (mostly homemade) & beverages (mostly wine). The women would walk or take their golf carts and move from home to home and enjoy mingling with old timers, new neighbors, and women you never had the chance to meet before. The first Progressive Dinner was held in 1996 when 20 women enjoyed appetizers at Cathy Marasco's house followed by dinner at Maria's and desserts at the home of Pat Fleischman. Over the years it had become so popular that the dinner portion had to be held at the clubhouse to accommodate the growing number of participants. For the last several years, the dinner portion has been eliminated and the women enjoy appetizers and desserts at two homes. This year Lisa Lee on Woods Road hosted appetizers and Florence Iavarone on Lakeshore So. hosted desserts. Over 60 women of the Knolls enjoyed stunning lake views and feasted on delicious food & beverages. A great time was had by all.

On another note, men were never included in this annual event so they decided to organize their own venue. Twelve years ago the Beer of the Knolls was organized by Jerry Garbowski and mimicked the house to house concept with 3 homes hosting kegs of beer and catered food. Following its popularity, they too now gather at two homes. Next Friday men will mingle at the homes of Dave Clegg and Casey White and fingers crossed ... the weather will cooperate and the turnout will be huge.
